DEFINITION

A Direct Support Professional for Art Inspired Academy is an entry level position providing desired supports and assistance to persons with developmental disabilities so that they may participate in Academy classes including music, theatre, visual arts, movement and additional creative arts programs. Experience in dance or fitness is highly recommended. This position will develop to include being the lead instructor as needed in the classes such as, theatre, movement, movie making, young child arts and more. This employee assists in the implementation of the personal plans developed for each person requiring support or assistance; contributes to the development of opportunities for inclusion; and establishes effective interpersonal relationships with the person being assisted, co-workers, parents and/or guardians, and other members of the treatment team. Work involves responsibility for providing necessary assistance to the individual needing supports, observing and reporting information concerning the physical, mental, and behavioral condition of the individual receiving support and assisting in the maintenance of necessary records and reports to document these observations. This team member will also work with the Inclusion Specialist to promote and educate the community about Art Inspired Academy using social media and verbal presentation. Close supervision or direction is received from the Program Manager or other staff members who reviews work through reports and direct observation. Evenings and weekends possibly required.

This description may not include all of the duties, knowledge, skills, or abilities associated with this position.
