Wolfner Library is a free public library service offering postage-paid materials to people who do not use standard print items due to having a visual, physical, or reading disability. Wolfner Library provides free access to audio, braille, and large print materials to users of all ages as well as a free audio and web braille download service. Playback machines are available from Wolfner to people who use audiobooks. Additionally, Wolfner provides over 70 different magazine subscriptions, a library newsletter, STEM kits, a summer reading program, print/braille games, accessible crafting, and story time videos.
